Captive Ring Goblet

More Woodturning Magazine is a monthly, online publication for turners who primarily turn wood. It is designed to provide educational material and guidance in woodturning techniques and to keep readers informed about what is happening in the woodturning world. Annual subscriptions can be purchased for the very reasonable cost of \$25; this allows visitors to read the magazine content online or print it out for easy reading. Each edition is released on the first day of the month and announced to subscribers via email (with a link for ease of access). According to Publisher and Editor Dennis Daudelin, a self-professed computer geek and one-time production turner, their goal is to provide new and valuable information for individuals interested in wood turning and turned wood, including woodturning project tutorials and articles, turner profiles, product reviews, new product announcements, and general news of interest to woodturners. Dennis took over the reins from Fred Holder a couple years ago when Fred retired after publishing over 180 editions in 20 years.

To help newsletter editors, *More Woodturning Magazine* has created a Club Newsletter Support Program -- a free service for registered club newsletter editors who receive a monthly email containing a list of woodturning events and a step-by-step tutorial or article which they can include in their newsletter in several formats including a link to a web page that displays the content.
